Building & Grounds Meeting
January 16, 2018

President Doug Martin called the meeting to order on January 16, 2017, at 4:30 P.M. in the Library at the grade school. Roll call was taken. Tim Erikson, Sarah Joos, and Caleb Wyss from Core Construction gave a PowerPoint presentation. Core Construction is a construction management company that is based in Morton, IL. The company was founded in 1937 and has grown to 8 other states. They are the 4th largest K-12 contractor in the country.

Core Construction would be involved from the early planning stages through the final project. They can help with preparing for the referendum, show virtual plans of the outside as well as the inside of the project, work with the client and architect, be involved with the subcontractors, and have someone on site full time.

Keith Poettker and Jon Carroll, from Poettker Construction also showed a PowerPoint presentation about their company. Poettker Construction is also a construction management company. They are a family owned business started in 1980 in Breese, IL. Some awards they've gotten are Top 150 Privately Held Companies for 3 years, Top 25 Largest General Contractor for 5 consecutive years, and 2017 Family Business Award (2nd Generation Category).

Keith spoke on how the kids would continue to attend school during construction, getting the community excited, bid processing, and being a liaison for School Board. They would use 3D modeling to see if things will work together and provide a link for the community to view.

Mr. Hamm told both companies they would be in contact with them.
