February 20, 2018

President Doug Martin called the meeting to order on February 20, 2018, at 4:30 P.M. in the Unit Office. Roll call was taken. Present were Deanne Mott, Charlie Hickey, Ashley Combs, Eric Cowan, Aaron Wilham, Jeff Beccue, and Doug Martin. Also present were Superintendent Hamm and Louis Volle.

The Board members, along with Louis Volle and Superintendent Hamm, took a walk around the school in order to see the condition of the grade school and see what needs the most attention. The first stop was the gym. Louis explained how there would be two, 2 ton units on the roof for air conditioning. There will be collapsible duct work along the ceiling and vented out the windows.

The cafeteria plans are to have new windows put in like the ones in the front of the building, air conditioning, and some new tables. The air conditioning will be 5 cassettes in the ceiling at an approximate cost of \$30,000.

Some restrooms will get new fixtures, lighting, partitions, and new flooring.

The lift is needing replaced due to being outdated and no availability of parts. The Board is still looking into what options are available.

Several doors inside the building will be replaced with higher grade of doors that will be more bullet resistant than what we have now.

Charlie Hickey stated that Roger Bohn inquired about the flag pole that use to be on the northwest corner of the lawn. He wanted to know why it wasn't being used. There is a flag pole outside the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classrooms that is being used.
