Other scholarship opportunities may come in the mail to you, and some of these require you to pay a fee for information or to enter the competition. In general, you are advised not to participate in and scholarship program that requires a fee, as the same information is generally available online without cost.

The **FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is the form you must complete for financial aid through the state and federal government. The form will be available online or you can request a paper copy. The FAFSA requires information from your 2016 federal income tax form, so be sure to have your taxes calculated before you fill out this form. The website is: www.fafsa.ed.gov
